Re-accreditation Support for Accredited Challenge Award Schools

Pre-Re-accreditation Visit

Designed to assist schools in refining evidence of the school improvement journey over the last 4 years, with attention to the key issues from the Challenge Award Report and evidence of leadership with impact.

The visit lasting between 2 and 3 hours, consists of:

- A trained Re-accreditation Assessor supporting the school's Gifted and Talented lead in examining the evidence of improvement with impact in relation to the key issues from the Challenge Award Report and the self evaluation matrix.
- A plenary session enabling the Gifted and Talented Lead to summarise how the school has decided to present the evidence of improvement and where further action or evidence is required before the audit day, to be shared with the Headteacher/ SLT.
- A note of visit summarising the outcomes and confirming the term in which the school wishes to apply for Re-accreditation.

Discussion of the matrices will include attention to:

- a sustained whole school commitment to designing and delivering high quality provision for able, gifted and talented pupils and that a culture of challenge for all has been sustained
- the impact of leadership and action
- What has the school done to improve? (Process/action evidence)
- What are the outcomes? (Impact evidence)
- how the school can evidence improvements and their impact
- the Challenge Award standards required
